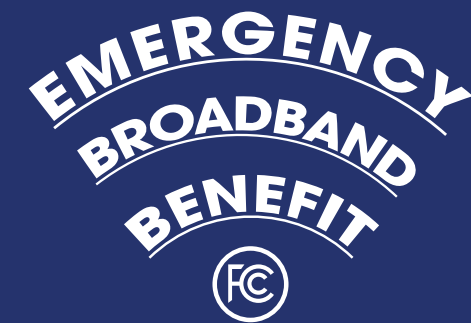


EMERGENCY BROADBAND BENEFIT

Need help with **Internet** costs?



STEP 1 Do I qualify?

Visit [GetEmergencyBroadband.org/do-i-qualify/](https://www.getemergencybroadband.org/do-i-qualify/) or call 833-511-0311 to see if you're eligible.



STEP 2 If you qualify, what best describes your situation?

I have no Internet service.

- Check to see if you qualify by calling **833-511-0311**.
- Apply via **National Verifier** and then pick a participating Internet service provider.
- Apply via a participating Internet service provider.

I have a low-income Internet service.

- Call or go online to your internet provider. Ask or search for EBB
- If you use the discount for higher speed & cost service, you must "opt-in" to get your lower cost internet when EBB ends.
- Another option is to apply for the Emergency Broadband Benefit via **National Verifier** and get additional service from another provider.

I have Internet service but it's not part of a low-income program.

- Check with your Internet service provider to see if you can apply the discount to your current service or if you can pick a different level of Internet service and apply the discount.

I have Internet service but want to change my service.

- You could use the Emergency Broadband Benefit discount to get mobile service or add another Internet service for your household. (A household may only get one discount.)
- Apply at **GetEmergencyBroadband.org**, then choose an Internet service provider once approved.

I have a school-sponsored account.

- Check with your school to see when the sponsored account ends. Your options include:
 - Ask current internet provider if you can stay or enroll in a low-income internet program and use the Emergency Broadband Benefit discount.
 - Get internet from a new internet provider and apply for temporary EBB benefit. Consider an internet provider with an ongoing, affordable low-income internet program.

I have Lifeline service.

- You're automatically eligible but have to enroll to use the Emergency Broadband Benefit discount.
- You could keep same provider. You can apply the subsidy to your current level of broadband service or increase the level while on the Emergency Broadband Benefit.
- You could get a new Internet service provider to provide service and apply the discount to the new service.

I live on Tribal lands.

- If you live on Tribal lands and meet other eligibility requirements, you can receive a total monthly discount of up to \$75 as well as a device discount.
