



UPCOMING STREET PAVING

PROJECT DESCRIPTION: PAVEMENT WORK ON RAVENNA AVE NE AND NE 54TH STREET

Dear Neighbor,

Starting on **Saturday, October 1**, Seattle Public Utilities (SPU) contracting crews will begin paving **Ravenna Ave NE at NE 54th Street**. This work will require a full lane closure on northbound Ravenna Ave NE until the pavement has cured. **The lane is expected to re-open to traffic on Friday, October 7.**

This work is part of SPU's large 430 Pipeline Improvement Project. The Pipeline runs four miles from Volunteer Park to Maple Leaf Reservoir in Seattle and was built in the early 1900s as part of the region's drinking water system.



SCHEDULE:

Crews will work from **7 am to 5 pm from October 1 to 6**. Noisy work will begin after 8 am.

WHAT TO EXPECT DURING CONSTRUCTION:

- Pavement excavation, construction noise, dust, dirt, and vibrations
- Parking restrictions near the work area
- Temporary bus stop closure and relocation
- Slowed vehicle traffic and detours
- Staging of equipment and construction vehicles near the project area
- Full lane closure on northbound Ravenna Ave NE for 6 days (Oct 1 to 6)
