Over the past two years, the Urban Forestry Commission has worked with the Urban Forest Inter-departmental Team and City Council staff on the production of the 2013 Urban Forest Stewardship Plan.

This update of the 2007 Urban Forest Management Plan contains changes to broaden the audience the Plan is speaking to and focuses on involving Seattle residents, organizations, and businesses alongside City government in the stewardship of this valuable resource. New sections in the Plan discuss *guiding principles, integrated approach, update process, priority actions, monitoring, funding, and future research needs*.

The Plan is written to provide clear guidance for the improved stewardship of our urban forest. The Commission supports the adoption of the Plan.
